

Examples of different levels of information sharing

Examples

Child needs food of a particular consistency in order to swallow safely	SLT All class staff. Kitchen staff Lunchtime supervisors involved with the child
YP has recently started menstruating	All class staff and other care staff who may be supporting. School Nurse
Parent of child is being treated at HIV clinic	School Nurse May possibly be shared with HT is needed
Child is learning to use the toilet independently	All class staff and other care staff who may be supporting or responsible at any time during the day. Lunchtime supervisors.

The examples refer to information sharing in school and assumes parents/carers are fully aware of all the issues. With older young people there may be issues that are raised which they do not wish to share with parents. While this is likely to be rare in school the relevant framework for decision making is the Mental Capacity Act for those over 16 years.
